



Registered Apprenticeship Program (RAP) Scholarship Award

Each year the Bonnyville Oilmen's Society awards one one-time \$1000 scholarship to a graduating student who is enrolled in one of the Alberta Red Seal Interprovincial Apprenticeship Programs. A full list of acceptable programs can be found on the Alberta Advanced Education website.

Candidate requirements for application are as follows:

- Applicant must be a graduate or graduating from Grade 12 at one of the four Bonnyville schools (Off Campus, Notre Dame High, BCHS and Ecole des Beaux-Lacs) that fall within the society membership boundaries. The Society boundaries and map are available on the Contact us page.
- Applicant must be enrolled in an Alberta Red Seal Interprovincial program.

- Letter of reference from your RAP coordinator
- Letters of reference from any community involvement you were involved in
- A completed application form
- A short essay describing why you are a deserving candidate

- Candidate selection will occur in September, and the Bonnyville Oilmen's Society will contact only those who are successful.
